Key messages

1. City Centre Footfall – Broadgate weekly

- Slides 5 to 8 show data from the secondary source of footfall data, which measures one entrance to Broadgate. This data is more up to date, giving an indication of recent weekly trends. But this is just one location.
- It shows footfall at this location during the last week ending 17th March 2024, footfall has decreased by 4.6% compared to the previous week ending 10th March 2024, while the UK average footfall decreased by 2.8%.
- Overall levels for week ending 17th March 2024 were down by 9.9% than at the same time last year —the UK high street average went down by 2.2 %.
- The year-to-date percentage of footfall in Coventry City Centre for the week ending on 17th March 2024 has decreased by 15.6%, whereas in the UK, it has seen a lower decline of 1.6%.
- Slide 6 focuses on the change for each day in the week ending 17th March,2024. It shows that footfall was lower week-on-week for most of the days apart from Sunday, 17th March 2024. Saturday, 16th March has highest footfall during this week.
- Slide 7 compares hourly footfall by hour for the last week. The peak hour for week ending 17th March 2024 was between 12 pm and 1 pm on Saturday, 16th March 2024.
- Slide 8 shows the daily footfall trend line from July 2022 to 19th March 2024, the most recent data is therefore newer than the weekly data ending 17th March 2024 discussed above.


3. Car parking in the city centre

- This slide provides information on car parking usage for the week ending 17th March 2024.
- For the week ending 17th March 2024 the overall usage level recorded was 8% lower than the week ending 10th March 2024.
- The weekday usage levels for week ending 17th March 2024 recorded was 5% lower than week ending 10th March 2024.
- Weekend usage levels recorded was 19% lower than the week ending 10th March 2024. On Saturday 16th March the overall occupancy levels recorded decreased to 41% and on Sunday 17th March the recorded overall occupancy levels increased to 21%.
- Overall levels for week ending 17th March 2024 was 11% lower than at the same time last year.






Footfall Counts by day

Week 11: 11 Mar – 17 Mar Week 10: 04 – 10 Mar




Daily Broadgate footfall
